

Program Outcomes Report for CACREP Accredited Programs

The Spring Arbor University Master of Arts in Counseling Program (MAC) is housed in the School of Social Sciences. Both the Clinical Mental Health Counseling and the School Counseling Programs are CACREP accredited since July 2016. The following information is organized by CACREP-accredited program areas and reflects data for 2022-2023.

Clinical Mental Health Counseling (CMHC)

- The CMHC program is a 60-credit-hour program which includes a 100-hour practicum and a 600-hour internship experience.
- > There are currently 195 students enrolled in the CMHC Program.
- > Between Summer 2021 and Spring 2022, 48 students graduated from the CMHC Program.
- The 3-year completion rate of students in the program is 61% with a five-year completion rate of 69%.
- > The job placement rate of graduates from the CMHC program is 100%.

School Counseling (SC)

- The SC program is a 69-credit-hour program which includes a 100-hour practicum and a 600-hour internship experience in a school setting.
- > There are currently 61 students enrolled in the SC Program.
- > Between Summer 2021 and Spring 2022, 11 students graduated from the SC Program.
- The 3-year completion rate of students in the program is 61% with a five-year completion rate of 69%.
- > The job placement rate of graduates from the SC program is 100%.
